1ST DIGITAL PHOTOGRAPHY INTERNATIONAL COMPETITION

Regulations

1. The Hellenic Photographic Society (HPS) promotes and organizes the 1st Digital Photography International Competition, under the FIAP Patronage (No 2007/047) opened to worldwide photographers, amateurs and professionals. This digital contest will take place during the 9th Athens International Festival of Artistic Photography.

2. Subject

The competition has two sections :

- a) **Free**
- b) **Food.**

For the “food” section, we mean the food as a need, or pleasure, or energy source, or source and cause of life. We also mean : Food and health, Food and Personality, Food and Place, Food and Tradition, Food and Mentality, Food and Religion, Food and Philosophy or Food and Ceremony.

3. Modality

The contest is only for digital creations, submitted in one single cd or dvd. The contest is open for all pictures, digitally modified or not. Photographers that do not work with computers, can scan their works in commercial laboratories to get their images on cd or dvd. The submitted cd or dvd will not be returned to the participants. Together with the cd or dvd every entrant must sent the entry form and the corresponding fees.

4. Works and resolution

Each author must be owner of the rights of the works he presents. Any part of the picture, even small must have been taken by the author who presents the work

Every participant can present up to four (4) works for each section. The submitted works can be either in color and / or black and white, no matter if they are taken by digital or analogue camera, digitized or elaborated by computer. For exhibition and printing reasons, the format of the submitted works must be in Jpeg 8 bit compression for Windows and permit a print size of 35-40 cm on the longer side under exactly 200 dpi.

5. File name coding

The file name coding of each work will be in 3 groups of maximum 25 characters (BLOCK letters) in total indicating by the following order

- a) the country ISO code in 2 characters, (list available on www.iana.org/cctld/cctld-whois.htm) followed by a hyphen,
- b) the authors name truncated to ten characters, followed by a hyphen and
- c) the sequential number of the photos, according to the respective section (FD for food, FR for free)

Example for Mr John Smith from Greece : GR_JOHNSMITH_FD1, or GR_JOHNSMITH_FR4

6. Participation fee

Participation fee is fixed to 15 euros (18 US \$) for one section or 20 euros (25 US \$) for both sections, or equivalent IRC. Cheques will not be accepted. Entries without proper fees will neither be judged nor returned.

No complaint about their decisions will be accepted.

9. Exhibition

All selected and awarded works will be printed by the HPS and presented under glass in metallic frames of 44 X 54 cm and in unified passe-partout.

10. Awards

For each section, one FIAP gold, silver and bronze medal, six FIAP honorable mentions, one HPS gold, silver and bronze medal and three HPS honorable mentions will be awarded.

11. Reproduction of works

By submitting the entry form, all entrants authorize the reproduction of their selected works, without any kind of limitation, as regards systems, means or countries and without payment of any kind of rights. The HPS is not responsible for the alteration of the works selected for the presentation-cd, which do not fulfill the requirements mentioned above. The entrants will take any responsibility in regard to the rights of third parties and in reference to image rights.

12. Presentation-CD Production and distribution

As this is a digital contest, a presentation-cd with all selected and awarded works will be published and mailed free of charge to all participants.

13. Note

The delivering of works must be exclusively by post. No email participation is accepted. Notifications will be by email. All entrants without e-mail will receive a printed notification. We strongly recommend proper packaging to avoid damage. The HPS is not responsible for any loss or damage of the submitted works. By taking part, all participants accept all the above rules and regulations. All cases not provided by these regulations will come under organizer's only competence.
